#### ***The EMS world is dressing up!***

A "Class A" dress uniform standard has been adopted by the EMS community (for a brief history, see [http://catalog.lighthouseuniform.com/ems/fallenEMT/ems\\_brief\\_history.php](http://catalog.lighthouseuniform.com/ems/fallenEMT/ems_brief_history.php)). It is a uniform that reflects the pride and uniqueness of Emergency Medical Services personnel. It also reflects a 'coming of age' and the EMS community's desire to take its rightful place with law enforcement and fire protection agencies at America's emergency services head table.

The *Good of the Order* option will result in a donation of \$50 to NEMSMA for every Class A uniform package purchased by a NEMSMA member. Help NEMSMA to grow and prosper while outfitting yourself or your agency in the industry-standard class A uniform designed especially for EMS personnel.

The *Every Director or Chief Needs a Class A Uniform* option provides a free class A uniform to a senior officer when the agency purchases seven "Class A" or "Honor Guard" uniform packages, or fourteen class A "Starter Packages." If you're senior staff is already outfitted, consider special staff officers such as your agency chaplain for this benefit.

The *Fallen EMT / Paramedic Dress Uniform Program* is a collaborative effort between the Lighthouse Uniform Company, JEMS and the National EMS Memorial, and is supported by NEMSMA. Its goal is to insure any EMT / Paramedic killed in the line of duty, be afforded the opportunity to be buried in a Class 'A' Dress Uniform. All that is required is a call from the EMS organization. The only cost to the agency is the cost of shipping the uniform.

We encourage all NEMSMA members and organizations that are not already outfitted to take advantage of these excellent officers.
